1) Fun cross craft!




What you will need:

6) Prayer Wheel




What you will need:

7) Bead Crosses





This is a great craft as it focuses your mind on Jesus' sacrifice for us, but also at the end of it you get to wear the necklace you made! There are multiple other designs around but the design above is super easy to start with!

8) Straw painting!



What you will need:

- -paper/card
- -different coloured paints
- -straws

This craft is super easy and fun! Just squeeze some blobs of paint around the page and use the straw to blow the paint around! You can make this more exciting by using multiple straws at once or trying to blow the paint from different directions.

This craft can be used to describe how God sent us the Holy Spirit to help us in our lives, and that when he first sent it '...it spread like wildfire' [Acts 2:4, The MSG]. Helps us to understand the characteristics of the Holy Spirit as fluid but still so important!

9) Biscuit decorating!





Use your imagination and get creative! Use your favourite bible stories as inspiration to decorate some tasty looking cookies! Examples could be creation, the plagues of Egypt, any of Jesus' miracles or parables (maybe the parable of the Lost Son – how good are you at drawing pigs?!)

10) Rainbow spotting!



What you need:

- --Cotton wool balls
- -card
- -coloured card
- -scissors
- -glue
- -optional ribbon to hang up

Why not spend time creating a rainbow and remembering God's amazing promise to us! God promised to Noah that he would never flood the whole Earth again and this is what the rainbow shows! Can you remember what order the colours of the rainbow are?

To make this lovely rainbow all you have to do is draw and cut out a cloud – this can be whatever shape you'd like your cloud to be. Then make your clouds fluffy by sticking lots of cotton wool on them.

The next step is to cut long strips of each of the coloured paper/card, before sticking them onto your cloud in rainbow order!
